ELECTRICIAN

Under the direction of the Electrical Supervisor, the Electrician is responsible for maintaining all electrical planned and unplanned repairs to the equipment. To repair the routine, emergency repairs of all fixed and mobile maintenance equipment. To maintain, with the highest standard of safety across the mine-site.
