Superintendent, Health And Safety

Reporting to the Health, Safety & Security Manager, the incumbent will be responsible for development, support and supervision of the Eagle Gold Project Health, Safety & Security program(s), monitoring and reporting, and have a strong command of Yukon’s Mine Health & Safety Act and all laws and regulations pertaining to the mining industry. The Health, Safety & Security Superintendent provides coverage for the Health, Safety & Security Manager in his absence. The duties in the Emergency Response/Safety Coordinators, Medics, Loss Prevention Officers and Security personnel. Approximately 5 direct reports. This position will be based at the mine-site, a remote camp working a rotational schedule. Responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

Main Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Develop safety programs in-line with the Yukon Mine Health and Safety Act.
- Implement Mine Rescue team and develop training programs.
- Liaise with Mining Inspection Services and maintain good relationships.
- Ability to work within a cross-cultural environment.
- Develop and maintain accident emergency action plan at site.
- Ability to conduct accident investigations and report in a timely manner.
- Develop Health & Safety Policies and Procedures.
- Health and Safety Monitoring
- WCB Monitoring and Reporting
- Provide daily, weekly, and monthly reports.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Preference will be given to candidates with a Degree/Diploma specializing in Health & Safety, Professional Safety Designation – CSO, CRSP. A number of years of experience in the Health & Safety field along with certificate courses will also be considered. Minimum of 5 to 8 years of Health & Safety experience in an industrial setting preferably in mining and operations. 5 plus years in a Supervisory Role and 3 plus years of emergency response team/mine rescue supervision or training experience.
- Advanced first aid certification – PCP, EMT, OFA 3, EMR.
- Mine Rescue Instructor Certification (or equivalent).
