Environmental Coordinator (Full Time)

Under the direction of the Environmental Superintendent, the Environmental Coordinator will be responsible for permit reporting, environmental monitoring and sampling, permit compliance, reclamation planning, preparation of closure and post closure plans and budgets, expansion planning and feasibility studies, and working with all Territorial, Federal and Local regulators on environmental related issues. The ideal candidate will possess a great work ethic with a drive for improvement. The position is site-based working a 4-week rotational schedule of 12-hour days. Responsibilities are noted below which will include but are not limited to:

Main Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Coordinate and conduct a variety of environmental sampling, documenting and reporting to fulfill regulatory and management plan requirements
- Liaise with Operations and stakeholders to implement best management practices to prevent discharge of wastes to the receiving environment
- Monitor operational activities, erosion and sediment control practices, waste management, and coordinate environmental documentation and investigations as needed
- Oversee maintenance of environmental monitoring equipment
- Lead record keeping, data compilation and processing, and regulatory report writing
- Participation in site-specific training and adherence to company health and safety and environmental policies

Qualifications and Experience:

- Five years of experience with practices, methods, and procedures in the environmental monitoring field, and coordination of programs in a northern location for a mining operation
