Heavy Duty Mechanic Apprentice

Under the direction of the Mobile Maintenance Supervisor and with the guidance of a Journeyperson, the HD Mechanic Apprentice is responsible for the planned and unplanned repairs to mobile, auxiliary and stationary mining equipment, while continuously aligning daily functions. The ideal candidate is one who is committed to safe working practices and strives for zero harm. This position will work on a rotational basis; 12 hours per shift. Responsibilities are noted below which will include but are not limited to:

Main Tasks and Responsibilities:

- Safety of self and others;
- Working with a team to conduct job risk assessments and safe work plans ahead of the work being completed and performing work in a safe and well-managed manner;
- Conducting preventative maintenance and servicing of mobile, auxiliary and stationary mining equipment;
