INSTRUMENTATION TECHNICIAN

Under the direction of the Electrical Supervisor, the Instrumentation Technician will work on instruments ranging from pressure transducers, weightometers, flow controllers, various level and temperature sensors, and ensuring all systems are wired to communicate with the DCS. The incumbent will be responsible for instrumentation equipment maintenance and regular field and programming troubleshooting/adjustments of equipment, ensuring the instrument readings are reliable and accurate at all times.
