LUBRICATION TECHNICIAN

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor, the Lubrication Technician will be accountable for all lubrication actives related to proper maintenance activities within the maintenance team. This position will work on a rotational basis. The incumbent will work with the maintenance team to establish the overall maintenance strategy for sit. Responsibilities are noted below which will include but are not limited to:
