EAGLE GOLD MINE OPERATIONS AND EXPLORATION

OPERATIONS AT VICTORIA GOLD'S EAGLE GOLD MINE REMAINED STRONG DESPITE

THE CHALLENGES of ramping up a new mine during the unprecedented conditions related to the global pandemic. The mine produced 35,312 ounces of gold in the third quarter.

"Our first quarter of Commercial Production included record tonnes mined including ore and waste, tonnes stacked on the pad and gold production and sales," says Victoria Gold President & CEO John McConnell.

"Effective health protection measures put in place have safe-guarded employees, contractors and local residents and enabled mine operations to continue," says McConnell. "We're in the late stages of operational ramp-up and the team has done a commendable job in identifying and rectifying the few remaining bottlenecks. This places the mine in a good position to continue to increase production in the fourth quarter of 2020 and into 2021."

A number of improvements on site were completed, or are in progress, and are significantly improving gold production moving forward.

The Victoria team also reached a significant safety milestone with no Lost Time Incidents (LTI) in the third quarter; achieving an impressive 2.7 million hours LTI-free at the Eagle Gold Mine through its construction and now operations.

The company also had a successful exploration season at its Dublin Gulch Property. The 2020 **Dublin Gulch Exploration Program focused** on Raven, Victoria's newest gold discovery, located to the east of the Eagle Gold Mine. The program included 13 drill holes designed to test the extent of the mineralization to prove that the trend is far larger than previously interpreted.

"We are very excited with the grade and scale Raven continues to return," continues McConnell. "Raven represents a highly-prospective target."
