

SUCCESSFULLY BUILDING THE EAGLE **GOLD MINE** over the past two years will be marked with the mine's first gold pour on Tuesday, September 17 from the mine site 85 kilometres north-northeast of Mayo.

The Victoria Gold team will livestream this momentous occasion so all Yukoners can be part of officially launching the territory's largest gold mine in history.

"The Eagle Gold Mine has been 10 years in the making, since Victoria purchased the property in 2009," says Victoria Gold Corp. President and CEO John McConnell. "We're extremely proud of our tenacity and commitment to make this mine a reality and of the opportunities we're able to provide Yukoners today and for decades to come."

During the mine's construction phase, the project employed over 600, with 440 working at site at any one time. About half were Yukoners, with many citizens of the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun and residents of the Village of Mayo. Since January, Victoria has hired hundreds of workers across many disciplines: 25 per cent of which are women. Now that operations have commenced and as they ramp up, it is anticipated the mine will directly employ 350 to 400 workers.

The Eagle Gold Mine will produce doré from a conventional open pit operation with a three-stage crushing plant, in-valley heap leach and gold recovery plant.
