IN 2009, VICTORIA GOLD ACQUIRED ITS FLAGSHIP ASSET, the 100-per cent owned Dublin Gulch Property, which includes the company's Eagle Gold Project; on track to be Yukon's next gold mine.

Currently under construction with over 700,000 hours into a 1.5 million hour build, Eagle is steadily advancing towards operations and the future mine's first gold pour in the second half of 2019.

The Project's progression over the past several years demonstrates Victoria's firm dedication to its people and partnerships.

With a total of 400 workers on site at any one time, half of which are Yukoners, Victoria is committed to the success of the Project and to ensuring positive social and economic benefits to the territory's residents and communities.

The Eagle Gold Project, currently under construction, and future gold mine is part of Victoria's 100 per centowned Dublin Gulch gold property located approximately 375 kilometres north of Whitehorse and 85 kilometres north, northeast of the Village of Mayo within the traditional territory of the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun. The property is accessible by road year-round and is within Yukon Energy's electrical grid.
