She is also the President of Whitehorse-based CSR Management, in addition to her founding/leadership role in YukonWIM, is co-founder of the Arctic Indigenous Investment Conference and most recently, on International Women's Day this year, launched WE.ArcticImpact with co-founder Lynn Hutton – a new initiative to support inclusive and diverse economies which enhance the economic empowerment of women and girls throughout the Arctic.

Anne was also instrumental in Kate Carmacks' 2019 induction into the Canadian Mining Hall of Fame.

Anne is the second Yukoner to receive this award in its 10-year existence. In 2017, geologist and YukonWIM Champion Sue Craig garnered the recognition.
