**IMPLEMENTED** Comprehensive Cooperation and Benefits Agreement, or CBA, between Victoria Gold and the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun (NND), in 2012 a scholarship program was established to support NND citizens pursue their post-secondary education paths.

Since the Victoria Gold NND Scholarship Program began, \$100,000 has been awarded to 97 NND students attending university, college or trades and technical courses. There are two application intakes each year (Fall and Winter) and the scholarship funds may be used for tuition, school supplies and equipment, rent, food, day care and/or transportation costs to help support student success.


