EVERY STUDENT, EVERY DAY, VICTORIA GOLD'S **REGISTERED CHARITABLE INITIATIVE**, which works with community and government partners to raise awareness and funds to support increased student attendance throughout the Yukon, is hosting its eighth annual fundraising gala on Saturday, October 5 at the Yukon Convention Centre in Whitehorse.

The event has flourished since the first gala was held in September 2012 and the Convention Centre's large capacity reflects Yukoners' growing awareness of and support for Every Student, Every Day and the importance of students attending school each and every day.

Since its establishment, the Victoria Gold Yukon Student Encouragement Society's Every Student, Every Day supporters and volunteers have raised and distributed over \$500,000 to directly fund 90 student attendance projects in schools and Yukon First Nations in almost every community in the territory.

Just this spring, Every Student, Every Day distributed \$100,000 to 21 new projects, which will be implemented in the 2019-2020 school year.

"We know one of the most important things our territory's students can do is also one of the most basic: Go to school every day," says the Society's

## **ABOUT VICTORIA GOLD & THE EAGLE GOLD MINE**

The Eagle Gold Mine, now in production, is part of Victoria's 100-per cent-owned Dublin Gulch Property located approximately 375 kilometres north of Whitehorse and 85 kilometres north, northeast of the Village of Mayo within the traditional territory of the First Nation of Na-Cho Nyak Dun. The property is accessible by road year-round and is connected to Yukon Energy Corp's electrical grid. The mine will be a significant contributor to Yukon employing 350 to 400 people.
